

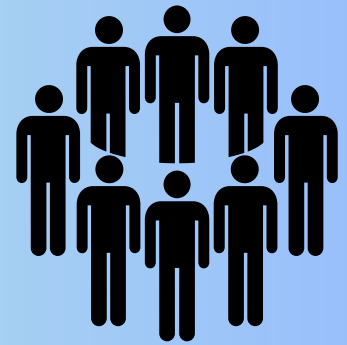

WHAT IS SEALING YOUR RECORD?

- Arkansas does not expunge; your criminal history still exists
- “Sealing” hides the record from some
- Great for jobs and housing

AM I ELIGIBLE TO SEAL MY RECORD?

- Have you completed all of the terms of your sentence?
- Paid all your fines and fees?

HOW DO I SEAL MY RECORD?

- Zaffino Law Firm will request your criminal history from ACIC, your sentencing order, & motion the Court to seal your record.
- A court hearing is usually not required.

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO SEAL MY RECORD?

- It depends. Some counties are quicker than others.
- Plan for at least 30 days.

WHY SHOULD I SEAL MY RECORD INSTEAD OF GETTING A PARDON?

- Approximately 400-500 pardon applications are accepted each year
- Only 100 of those applications are granted

WHO CAN SEE MY SEALED RECORD?

- The Arkansas Crime Information Center
- Prosecuting Attorneys if requested
- Judges if requested

HOW MUCH DOES SEALING MY RECORD COST?

- Estimated cost for misdemeanors is \$500.00
- Estimated cost for felonies is \$1,000.00
